

# English Language Arts policies and procedures

## Reading and Writing Assignments

Throughout the year, students will be reading several novels. I will communicate the selected novel and reading schedule to the students in class and parents via email.

There will be a major writing assignment every 9 weeks.

## Independent Reading

Research has shown that independent reading a student-selected book builds reading comprehension, vocabulary, fluency, writing skills, and empathy.

With this in mind, we will be independent reading in class several times a week. Students are responsible for having a book to read and keeping up with their independent reading journal.

## PARENTS

It is best to contact me through email. I will get back to you within 24 hours.

Please, encourage your student to read at home at least 20 minutes a night. Reading is the best way to guarantee their success in every class.

Make sure you have access to Infinite Campus and regularly have conversations with your student about grades. If you do not have access, let me know and I can get you in contact with someone to help you.

I encourage you to be as involved in your child's high school experience as possible. Attend everything you can! Read the books their reading in class!

## ABSENCES AND RETAKES

Weekly and daily work will be updated weekly. Please check grades regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about a particular grade.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work.

All make-up work will be placed in your classes absent folder and your name will be written on any work you missed.

If you missed a test or quiz, you are responsible for scheduling a time to take the assessment.

Per MNPS policy, you will have four weeks from the original due date to retake any assignments. You are responsible for scheduling a time to retake.
